

Frassati Fellowship of Catholic Young Adults Spring Retreat

March 9-11, 2007

Theme: “Christian Community in Our Challenging World”

This retreat will focus on building Christian community in the challenging world we live in. The talks, prayers, and workshops will offer a chance to explore our role as brothers and sisters in Christ. A workshop on leading worship by the Catholic Underground Worship Team will be held for music ministers. We will celebrate daily Mass and have Eucharistic adoration, and priests will be available for the Sacrament of Reconciliation. There will also be time for recreation and opportunities for both silence and for fellowship. Frassati Fellowship retreats are an opportunity to be spiritually and physically nourished and refreshed, to make and nurture meaningful Christian friendships, and to follow in the footsteps of Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati as together we ascend “To the Heights!”

Location: Emmanuel Marianist Retreat House at Kellenberg Memorial High School – 1400 Glenn Curtiss Boulevard, Uniondale, New York 11553

Time: Registration begins at 7:00pm Friday. The retreat will conclude at approximately 2:00pm Sunday.

Cost*: The retreat fee includes the retreat, meals and accommodations for the weekend, and transportation to and from New York if required (see below).

Dates: Friday, March 9, 7:00pm – Sunday, March 11, 2:00pm

Location: Emmanuel Marianist Retreat House, Uniondale NY

Bring: All bedding, towels, and meals will be provided. You may want to bring a rosary, Bible, journal, and good walking shoes.

Van from Manhattan*: Departs at 6:15pm Friday from St. Elizabeth of Hungary Church in Manhattan (211 E. 83rd St, b/w 2nd & 3rd Avenues). ***RSVP on registration form**

Driving Directions*: Northern State Pkwy connects directly to Meadowbrook Pkwy. Take Meadowbrook Pkwy to Exit M4, Hempstead Turnpike West. Exit ramp is very long and parallels the Meadowbrook Pkwy. The exit goes directly on to Hempstead Turnpike (West). Proceed cautiously but quickly into the left lane as you approach the first traffic light. The European American Bank is on your left and the Veteran's Coliseum and Marriot Hotel are on your right. Turn left at the traffic light onto Glenn Curtiss Blvd. Count two traffic lights. Make the first right after the second traffic light on to the Kellenberg campus.
